- 2 small passport photos
- Permanent resident card
- Driver's license or identification card
- Social security card
- Address and dates of previous employers and schools for the last 5 years
- Addresses of your previous places of residence for last 5 years
- All dates you have exited and entered the U.S. since you became a resident
- Names, addresses, Social Security numbers and Alien Identification numbers of all spouses (current & previous) and children
- Citizenship certificate number of current spouse (if naturalized)
- Dates of marriage(s)
- A certified check or money order for \$675.00 made out to: *U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services*

- Orientation on becoming a U.S. citizen
- Free help to complete citizenship application
- Assistance in English, Spanish and Vietnamese
